We confirm, that the nickel metal hydride batteries used in our product

e-motion (M10, M12)

are classified as

UN Nr. 2800 „Batteries, gel, nonspillable, electric storage“

according to IATA (International Air Transportation Association).

According to special provisions A-67 of IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations, they are considered as non-dangerous goods on transportation. No electrolyte will flow from cracked case at a temperature of 55°C.

The terminals have to be protected against short circuit by the delivered covers!

They are also considered as „nonspillable battery“ by DOT (U.S. Department of Transportation).

According to special provision 238.2 they are not subject of the provision of IMDG-Code.
