

Docking to the wheelchair

scalamobil can be connected to almost any type of wheelchair and can be assembled quickly without any tools. This allows wheelchair users to simply remain seated in their wheelchairs and still easily overcome any barriers in their own home or when out and about.

 scalamobil can also be combined with nursing wheelchairs or particularly narrow wheelchairs.



scalacombi®

With integrated seat

scalacombi is the perfect mobility solution for people who need assistance when climbing stairs, but are not reliant on a wheelchair in their everyday life. The stair-climbing device features a comfortable, integrated seat and can be folded up and stowed away to save space.




Docking:

Accessories

01. Bracket

Bracket for attaching the scalamobil device to the wheelchair. You must specify the wheelchair type and seat width in your order.

02. Headrest

The soft upholstered headrest can be adjusted in terms of height, depth and angle. It provides support and stability for the neck and head.

03. Bracket for transporting wheels

The bracket allows you to transport the wheels of the wheelchair along with the scalamobil device to avoid unnecessary journeys. Compatible with all standard wheelchair models.

04. Anti-tippers

The anti-tippers can be removed using the quick-release fastener and can be adjusted in terms of height and length. The automatic swivelling function allows you to navigate kerbs and landings.

05. Automatic locking

Simple locking of the wheelchair to scalamobil (no quick pins and no more bending over).

06. Quick-release axle


You must first remove the wheels of the wheelchair to climb stairs with the scalamobil device. A quick-release axle system is required, which is available as a conversion kit and contains all the necessary components – including assembly for standard hubs and drum brakes.

07. Isofix connection (only scalacombi s46)

Allows child seats to be attached with ease.
